The Gifted & Academically Talented Students

Entrance to the Gifted program at Central Riverside requires special testing. The Academically Talented program is open to all students. Both programs incorporate innovative teaching, cooperative-learning groups and research projects. Students go beyond basic standards of achievement in programs that are accelerated in both pace and depth, including:

- Full day pull out Gifted instruction on-campus
- Enhancing, Developing & Generating Excellence (EDGE)—a pull out program designed to provide enrichment for those students identified as having potential for entrance into the Gifted program
- Art, music and physical education classes
- Multiple technology tools in each classroom

Students can also take advantage of continuity programs to the Gifted and Talented schools, James Weldon Johnson, Julia Landon or Darnell-Cookman Middle Schools with opportunities to continue on to Stanton and Paxon High Schools.
