The ability to adapt to one's environment through discoveries, investigating and observing

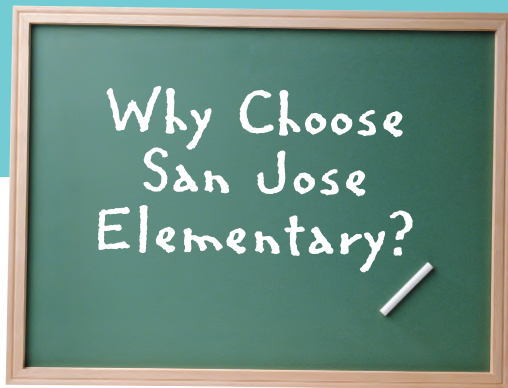
