ENCOUNTERING SCIENCE

The Dinsmore Science Studies program is designed to create enthusiasm and excitement through direct experiences with the sciences. Microscope investigations, observing live animals, building models, and exploring concepts through scientific teams allow students to apply knowledge to real-world situations. Technology is integrated into lessons and our butterfly and vegetable gardens offer additional learning adventures. Community partnerships support science enrichment activities and our annual standards-based science fair. Whether it's building a simple battery-powered motor or observing beetles going through metamorphosis, students at Dinsmore are engaged in challenging, real-life science applications.

STANDARDS-BASED INSTRUCTION

Principles of Learning in a Standards-based School:

- Standards-based schools are premised on five distinct principles of learning that are embedded in our whole school design, from the performance standards and state assessment tests to school organization and daily classroom instruction.
- Student effort is a more important determinant of achievement than natural ability.

- Getting all students to achieve at high levels depends on clear expectations that are the same for all students.
- All students need a thinking curriculum – one that provides a deep understanding of the subject and the ability to apply that understanding to the complex real-world problems that students will face as adults.
- Students of all ages learn best in two types of circumstances: when they are seeking and using knowledge and skills to address problems that challenge and engage them, and when they are teaching others.
- People learn well when working beside an expert who models skilled practice and encourages and guides learners as they create products or performances for audiences whose reactions really matter.
