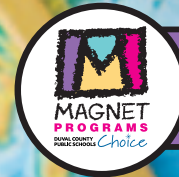

Fort Caroline Middle School is now a candidate school with the Middle Years Programme, and offers its students an approach to learning that goes beyond the scope of traditional school subjects. Students are inspired, encouraged, challenged and rewarded.

Fort Caroline's curriculum is based on three fundamental concepts: International Mindedness, Communication, and Holistic Learning.

ACADEMICS: Fort Caroline educates students to think deeply, live honorably and engage in contemporary intellectual and social challenges.

TECHNOLOGY: Facilities include technology-enhanced classrooms, brand-new computer laboratories, Read 180 laboratories, computer-accessed safety nets and creative design systems.

DIVERSITY: A strong sense of community brings students together to enhance the social and cultural education of all. Students at Fort Caroline represent over 40 countries.
