- Teachers who have received IB training in specific subject areas will teach Pre-IB and IB courses at Ribault.
- IB students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities.
- Students in Ribault's IB program may access the magnet transportation system.
- Colleges and universities worldwide seek IB students to attend their schools.
- Students gaining an IB Diploma are eligible for the Florida Bright Futures Academic Scholarship which awards 100% tuition and books to state universities.

## Admission Criteria

Completion of an application is required for entrance into the IB Program. Students are selected based on grades, test scores, and teacher recommendations. In addition, students must successfully complete Algebra I while in middle school. There will be a limited number of seats available for each incoming class. Students must meet the minimum requirements and submit all required information by the school's chosen deadline to be considered.

### Success...The journey begins here

Jean Ribault High administrators, faculty, and staff are proud to announce that in April 2007, Jean Ribault High School was granted full authorization as an IB World School and can offer the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program. Every student deserves a well-rounded high school experience, that challenges him or her to learn, analyze and prepare for life beyond the classroom.

Students come to Ribault from all over Duval County to participate in general and Military Science programs. This community of learners is inclusive of IB students, who are able to get the full high school experience and contribute to the social climate of the school.

## IB...The Foundation of Lifelong Learning

During the 9th and 10th grades, students take courses to prepare them for the IB Diploma Program that begins their junior year. The program lets graduates fulfill the requirements for a variety of national education systems.

The IB program is a rigorous curriculum that focuses on the liberal arts and sciences. Students travel together in small cohorts for most of the day to take English, foreign language, mathematics, science, history, and the arts (required elective). For each of the six subject areas, an exam is taken during junior and senior year. Students gain college credit based on their exam scores and according to the college or university criteria. There are also additional requirements that include community service (CAS), a research project (Extended Essay), and a Theory of Knowledge course.

## Involvement...The Trojan Way

Ribault High School has a rich legacy that has produced generations of distinguished members of society, community leaders and world-class athletes. IB students do not have to forgo other important parts of high school life. Our students are participating in extracurricular activities including football, volleyball, band, basketball, ROTC and clubs. Such activities\* are well incorporated into the IB Diploma Program, as well, through the "CAS" (Creativity Action, and Service) requirement.

Other student activities\* include Thespian Club, Key Club, Math Club, Beta Club, Model U.N., National Honor Society, Ribault Reads Book Club, Robotics Club, *Trojan Tribune*, World Languages Club, Soccer, Cheerleading, Track, Cross Country, Swim, and Tennis.
