A. Philip Randolph Academies of Technology is a unique high school dedicated to student achievement through rigorous academic and career preparatory programs.

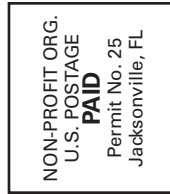

# Public Safety & Criminal Justice

A. Philip Randolph Public Safety is divided into five pathways. Each pathway provides instructional foundations necessary for students to become successful in a myriad of career and educational pursuits.

- **Corrections Services**
- **Emergency and Fire Management Services**
- **Security and Protective Services**
- **Law Enforcement Services**
- **Legal Services**



A. Philip Randolph Criminal Justice program gives students hands-on experience in the field of legal services. Students learn from field and laboratory activities including basic procedures in traffic control, patrol, search and arrest, stop and frisk, mock trial, jail operations, crime prevention, fingerprinting, forensic and crime scene laboratory examination procedures. Students also learn from field trips and guest speakers in the area of criminal justice.



The program sets long-range goals of Law Enforcement, Law and Administration. Students pursue careers in legal, public safety, protective services and homeland security, including professional and technical support services. Numerous job openings will stem from employment in the career field of Law. Concerns about criminal activity and drug related crimes contribute to the increasing demand for Public Safety Careers.

A. Philip Randolph Public Safety program emphasizes private security and corrections as entry level jobs into the Criminal Justice System and Law Enforcement. These are long-range goals. A. Philip Randolph Academies is the *only* high school in the state of Florida that teaches the Private Security Guard Course and the *only* public high school in Florida that is licensed by the state of Florida to certify students as having completed the twenty four-hour initial course required to obtain class "D" security guard licenses.

### The Security, Corrections and Law Enforcement Course has two major goals:

- To teach and place students in the private security and corrections profession upon graduation.
- To prepare the students for college to study law, law enforcement and other related career fields.

In order to achieve the goals of the program, we've welcomed industries that employ our students as members of the program advisory board. The Law Enforcement and Private Security Council of Northeast Florida, along with the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office act as advisors to the program.

In addition, Randolph Academies and its criminal justice instructor are licensed by the State of Florida to certify students for completion of requirements for an unarmed security guard licensure.

# Public Safety Fire and Rescue

A. Philip Randolph has partnered with the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department to create our Fire and Rescue Career Academy. This prepares students for a thrilling career in Firefighting or Emergency Medical Services. Students enrolled in this Academy have the opportunity to participate in the Explorers Program and acquire hands-on, real-world experience.

The Firefighting program content includes, but is not limited to, orientation to the fire service, fire alarms and communication, vehicles apparatus and equipment, fire behavior, portable extinguishers, fire streams, fundamentals of extinguishment, ladders, hoses, tools and equipment, forcible entry, salvage, overhaul, ventilation, rescue, protective breathing equipment, first responder emergency medical techniques, water supplies, principles of in-service inspections, safety, controlled burning, and employability skills.
