In the San Pablo Magnet Program, students participate in activities with physical education and classroom teachers who provide standards-based instruction through best teaching practices.

We teach team-sport skills such as soccer, basketball, softball and football as well as individual-sport skills including tennis, golf, bowling, running club and walking club.

Students also gain experience in perceptual motor skills and life-long activity fitness skills. In addition, students may participate in the Swim America Program, a course offering instruction that follows Red Cross guidelines.



Outstanding Facilities and Activities.

San Pablo Elementary School benefits from a wide range of outstanding facilities that are part of our greater campus. These include the on-site Boys and Girls Club gymnasium and tennis courts as well as community soccer fields.
