Academic PROGRAMS

In keeping with Stanton's emphasis on high academic standards, we offer a wide range of programs and curriculum options. These include honors, Advanced Placement, and dual enrollment courses, as well as the International Baccalaureate Program (IB).

Our IB Program provides a maximum challenge to the most academically motivated and talented students in grades eleven and twelve. Successful completion of the program earns course credit accepted by colleges and universities around the world.

Each year, Stanton is first in the district for the number of students who qualify for the National Merit Scholar Program, the National Achievement Program and the National Hispanic Scholar Program. Stanton is also consistently in the top 1% of the number of students qualifying for these programs from all schools throughout the state.

Stanton students receive an extraordinary number of scholarships from colleges and universities throughout the country. Over 75% of Stanton students receive the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship. The amount of merit-based scholarship money offered to Stanton seniors continues to be in excess of eight million dollars a year.

ADMISSIONS

Any student who is willing to accept the challenge of our advanced curriculum may apply for admission to Stanton through the Duval County Magnet Office. Students applying to the International Baccalaureate Program should apply directly through the Stanton Guidance office.
