



What is a Multiple Intelligences Magnet Program?

Thomas Jefferson Elementary School's Multiple-Intelligences program recognizes that everyone is smart in different ways. We address all eight types of each child's intelligence:

- **Verbal/linguistic:** involves using words and language (Word Smart)
- **Musical/rhythmic:** emphasizes the ability to use pitch, rhythm and tone (Music Smart)
- **Logical/mathematical:** uses reasoning, problem solving, numbers and relationships (Number Smart)
- **Visual/spatial:** uses the student's ability to visualize an object in three dimensions to create mental images (Art Smart)
- **Bodily/kinesthetic:** focuses on the body and movement in harmony (Body Smart)
- **Naturalist:** involves understanding the environment and how it affects us (Nature Smart)
- **Intrapersonal:** emphasizes the student's thoughts and feelings (Self Smart)
- **Interpersonal:** recognizes the student's strengths in person-to-person relationships to communicate and work with others toward a common goal (People Smart)
